

## Evaluation Criteria for incluD-ed Good Practices

To gain a greater insight into good practices and the manner in which they have a bearing on the development of inclusive education for people with disabilities, the coordinators of incluD-ed have put together a set of evaluation criteria. We would appreciate your cooperation in reflecting upon and illustrating the extent to which your practices have achieved results according to the criteria outlined below.

### 1. IMPACT

- a. The practice demonstrates, by means of qualitative and/or quantitative results, an improvement in the educational, social or working conditions of people with disabilities.
- b. The practice has exerted an impact on the media.

### 2. INNOVATION

- a. The practice integrates new elements of intervention to achieve the inclusion of people with disabilities.
- b. The practice contributes progressive tools, facilities, technologies or processes to the field of inclusion.

### 3. TRANSFERABILITY

- a. The practice's progressive and/or established ideas may be applied to parallel or similar situations in the same or different regions.
- b. The practice acts as a source of inspiration for new projects.

### 4. SUSTAINABILITY

- a. The practice leads to lasting changes in the way of working and strategic planning in the long term.
- b. The practice involves a wide range of actors and stakeholders that help sustain the project financially.

## 5. PARTICIPATION OF PEOPLE WITH DISABILITIES

- a. The practice includes people with disabilities in decision-making.
- b. The practice involves people with disabilities at all stages of the project.

## 6. BROAD-BASED PARTICIPATION

- a. The practice enjoys the collaboration of various administrations and government bodies that afford their support to the project.
- b. The practice enjoys the cooperation of bodies and/or people from various social sectors, who strive towards the pursued goals and are committed to the success of the practice.

## 7. EVALUATION

- a. The practice includes an evaluation of the practice itself.
- b. The practice involves the various people that have taken part in the project in the evaluation phase.
